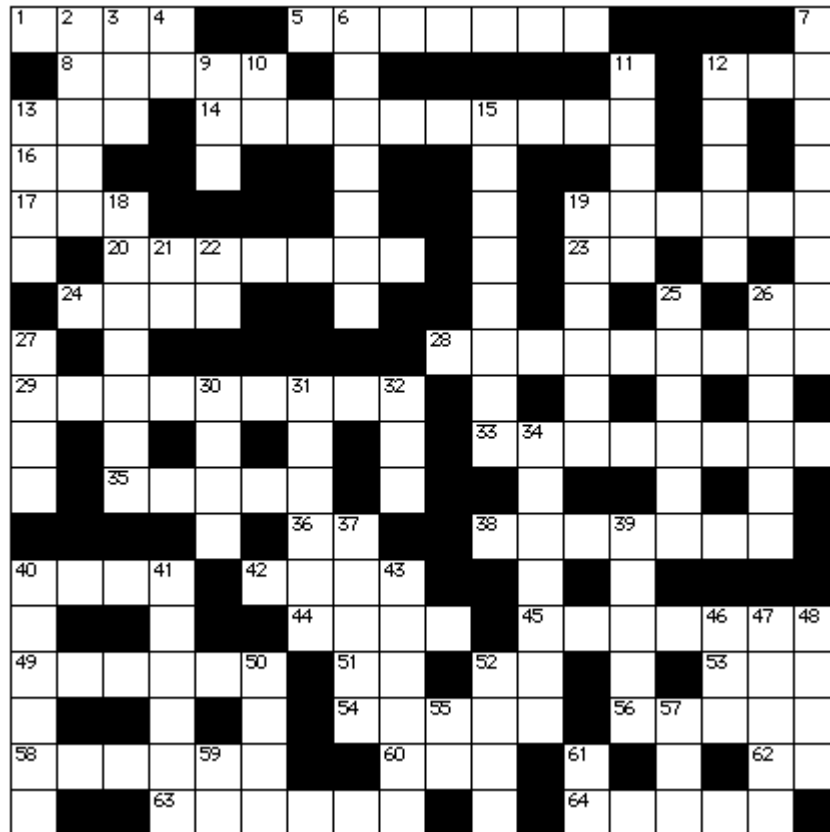


CHRISTMAS HEROS AND VILLAINS

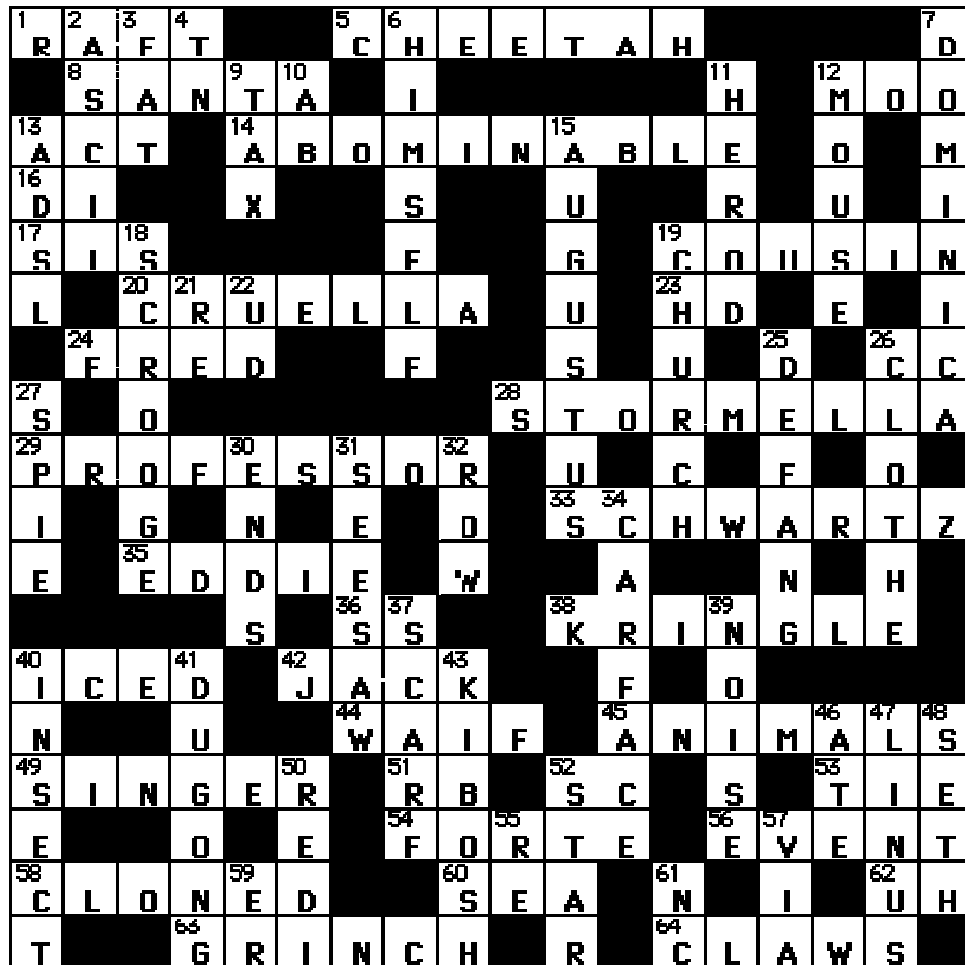
